How to use this check sheet:

In each column list the course and prefix number that fulfills the corresponding requirement. In the appropriate column next to the course, write the number of semester credit hours. i.e. if you have completed the course mark the number of hours under the C column. If it is a course that you have not earned a grade for yet, mark the number of semester credit hours under the NC column. If the course is an upper division course (Jr. or Sr. level) also mark the number of credit hours in the UD column next to the course.

When cross listing courses (using the same class to fulfill two requirements) take extra care not to double count the credit hours. Write the number of hours under one of the requirements, and cross out the appropriate column under the cross-listed requirement.

Key

C = Courses completed

NC = Courses not yet completed

UD = Upper division courses (300 and above at ASU)

DARS = Degree Audit Reporting System. This column is for advisor's use only. / Check if the course is already articulated into the DARS report.

¹ When cross listing do not count credit again.

² A total of 15 hours must be taken from both the University General Studies Humanities/Fine Arts (HU) and College Graduation Humanities areas. A total of 6 upper-division hours must be taken in CLAS Humanities.

A total of 15 hours must be taken from both the University General Studies (SB) and College Graduation Social/ Behavioral Sciences areas. A total of 6 upper-division hours must be taken in CLAS, Social/Behavioral Sciences.

Remember that the University General Studies combined HU and SB requirements requires a minimum of six hours in one area and nine in the other for a total of 15. At least one course must be at the upper division level.

Note: In the following examples; the course prefixes listed are **NOT** intended as suggestions of actual course work. They are provided only as examples. Please see the CLAS Curriculum Guide and the ASU General Catalog for information on what courses fulfill these requirements.
